

## **Grizzly 2019 – Sunday 10 March – Trails of the Unexpected**

### **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) on the entry/ballot process**

Q: I have a guaranteed place for the 2019 race – do I still need to enter the ballot?

A: Yes – you should enter the ballot and pay the entry fee in the usual way via the Full On Sport website (<https://www.fullonsport.com/event/grizzly-ballot-2019/profile>) and your entry will automatically pass the ballot. It is very important that you mark on your entry form that you had a place in the 2018 race.

Q: If I miss the entry deadline of 20:00 on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2018, can I still have my guaranteed place if I subsequently contact the race organisers?

A: No – everyone has to enter the race before the stated deadline. We will then know the number of guaranteed places before determining how many places are available for non-guaranteed entries in the ballot. If you miss the entry deadline, the only way to get a place in the race will be through the change of runner process.

Q: If I transferred my place prior to race weekend in 2018 can I still have a guaranteed place?

A: No – the guarantee applies to runners on the entry list as at 11am on Saturday 17 March 2018. If you were not on the entry list at that time, you will not receive a guaranteed entry but are able to enter the ballot for non-guaranteed places.

Q: If all those who were in last year are guaranteed a place will there be any places left?

A: Yes - we do not expect all those who had places in 2018 to enter the 2019 race so we expect there will be places available for others. We are also slightly increasing the number of runners in the 2019 race. Change of runners will also be allowed as in previous years.

Q: If I had a cub place this year (2018) can I enter the Grizzly next year (2019) and vice versa?

A: Yes, upon payment of the relevant race fee, you can enter either race next year irrespective of which race you were in this year.

Q: If I have a guaranteed place for 2019 but do not want to take part can I carry that guaranteed place into 2020?

A: No, this offer is only for the 2019 race.

Q: I have changed my email/mailling address since last year – will I still get a place?

A: Yes, so long as you have notified us of your new email or address as part of this year's entry, you will receive your guaranteed place.

Q: I have a guaranteed place for the 2019 race – do I need to pay for this place?

A: Yes, all runners have to pay for a place in the 2019 race, whether or not they have a guaranteed place.

Q: Do we get a discount for the 2019 race because we didn't get to run in 2018?

A: No, we are sorry but there will be no discounts – however, we have frozen last year's entry prices despite an increase in a number of our costs. It is important to remember that the Grizzly is organised by volunteers (not a professional company) and all last year's costs still had to be met plus all profits are donated to local community groups without which the race could not go ahead.

Q: What size t-shirts will be available this year and will I be able to change my selected size at any stage?

A: Seven unisex sizes will be available this year, XXS, XS, S, M, L, XL, XXL. No specific women's sizing will be available. Runners will not be allowed to change their t-shirt size from that selected on their ballot entry form so please ensure that you select the correct size using the sizing guide found on the Grizzly website. Any "new" runners who obtain a race number through the change of runner process will receive the t-shirt size selected by the original runner.
